Senior Registrations will be a total of \$480. \$130 online and \$350 club. (\$78 HQ. \$12 HA. \$40 Ins.)

Junior 16-17 years registrations will be a total of \$325. \$60 online and \$265 club. (\$34 HQ. \$10 HA. \$16 Ins.)

Juniors 12-15 years registrations will be a total of \$195. \$60 online and \$135 club. (\$34 HQ. \$10 HA. \$16 Ins.)

NEW RULE CHANGES FOR 2016!

Please find here information regarding an adjustment to Rule 13.2 and its guidance as follows:-

- At an attacking Free Hit within the 23 metres area, the ball now cannot be played into the circle until it has travelled at least 5 metres or been touched by a defending player i.e. the possibil-

ity for the attacker to just touch the free hit for a team mate to run on to and play the ball into the circle is removed.

- There is an additional piece of guidance added that following a time stoppage after the award of an attacking free hit inside the 23 metres area, upon the re-start all players

other than the player taking the free hit must be at least 5 metres from the ball.

Other than the above, the Rule and its interpretation remains exactly the same as at present. The opportunity had been taken to incorporate into the Rule the guidance that was previously separately issued in May 2015.

The Annual March Past for Junior Hockey is fast approaching for the 2016 season.

The Rockhampton Hockey Association Inc. and fellow Clubs wish to announce the 2016 March Past to be held on the 16th April from 8am. It is requested that all junior players arrive by 7:45am so clubs can get uniforms organized, boots checked and players lined up for an 8am start.

For all our new Frenchville Rovers, this is a fantastic way to officially welcome in the 2016 season with a March Past of all junior players with their coaches. There will be a pipe band and some local dignitaries to welcome in the new season. Make sure your children have their club socks and shorts/skirts on, playing shirts and hats will be given out before the March Past, and handed back in to your team manager once completed.

This years order will be Park Avenue, Frenchville Rovers, Southern Suburbs and Wanderers.
